G ½ Road Improvement project starts Monday

GRAND JUNCTION, CO April 25, 2008— A project to reconstruct G ½ Road near Bookcliff Gardens to install utilities and upgrade the road for new development will begin on Monday, April 28 and continue through the end of July.

26 Road will remain open throughout the project, but G ½ Road will be closed to thru traffic during construction. Access to Bookcliff Gardens will remain open on 26 Road. Access to Wilson Ranch and Woodridge subdivisions will be from either 25 Road and G ½ Road or 25 Road and G 3/8 Road.

Access to Blue Heron Meadow Subdivision and The Estates subdivision will be from G Road and Estates Blvd. Access into Blue Heron Meadow and The Estates will be closed from Beaver Lodge Road and G ½ Road.

The project will install underground utilities for two proposed subdivisions and future development in the area, and to improve G ½ Road. The first phase of construction involves building a new box culvert underneath G ½ Road to allow for the widening of G ½ Road. The second phase will include installing new underground utility pipes and rebuilding the roadway. The utility work includes a Ute Water District waterline, a sanitary sewer pipe, and concrete storm drain pipe. The roadway section will be rebuilt with asphalt, curb, gutter and sidewalk.

The \$952,000 construction contract was awarded to Scott Contracting, Inc. of Henderson, Colorado.
