GRAND JUNCTION, CO June 30, 2009—For those needing the latest demographic, social and economic, building and development and traffic statistics about Grand Junction and Mesa County, the **2007/2008 Data Book** is now available online at the City's website at [www.gjcity.org](http://www.gjcity.org)

The **2007/2008 Data Book: City of Grand Junction / Mesa County** is a compilation of statistical data prepared by the City of Grand Junction, Public Works and Planning Department. Information is compiled from statistics kept by the City, Mesa County, the State of Colorado, and federal sources.

"This is a valuable resource to our citizens and community," said Lisa Cox, Planning Division Manager. "It has a broad range of uses for government and citizens alike."

The data is extremely useful for anyone looking for statistics about Grand Junction and Mesa County to use in grant applications, people preparing reports for government commissions or boards, research projects for students, realtors doing a market analysis, or someone wishing to start a business and needing to write a business plan.

It contains data on everything from population, demographics, transportation, temperature, annual precipitation, household size, employment data, social and economic summary, sales tax, building permits and housing units, traffic analysis by population, to school enrollment, public safety and parks.
