Seven units and 22 personnel responded to report of house fire at 2842 Scott Street. First arriving unit E-14 found heavy smoke and fire in the carport that had extended into one room of the house and into the attic area. They were able to knockdown the fire fairly quickly. LD-11 and E-13 assisted with extinguishment and mop-up of the fire as well as water supply and utilities shut down. Water Tender 15 and E-15 were dispatched to assist with water supply and firefighter protection on scene.

There were 4 adults and one dog named Amber home at the time of the fire. Unusual sounds and the smoke detector alerted them to the fire. Fire was reported by multiple callers including the occupants of the home.

Cause of the fire is still under investigation at this time. No occupants or firefighters were injured due to

the fire. Red Cross was contacted to assist the occupants with shelter needs and fire recovery. Damage is estimated at around \$100,000.00.
