The Grand Junction Fire Department responded to a structure fire at 410 West Ouray Avenue with 4 units and 15 personnel. First arriving unit found the home evacuated by the owner and neighbors assisting by moving out a dresser drawer from a bedroom that was on fire. The fire started in the back of the dresser spread to the wall in the bed room. The fire was quickly extinguished. The occupant was treated on scene and transported to the hospital, by private vehicle, to the hospital for minor smoke inhalation. Two of the neighbors were also treated and released on scene for minor smoke inhalation. The fire was contained to one room in the home.

Damage is estimated at \$5,000.00. Cause of the fire is still under investigation. There were no injuries to firefighters due to the fire.
