Hit & Run Accident

GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO: On Thursday, June 14, 2007 at about 1246 a.m. Grand Junction Police officers responded to the intersection of North Avenue and 12th Street on a reported accident involving a motorcycle and passenger car. Investigation revealed the motorcyclist was traveling westbound on North Avenue and entered the 12th Street intersection when a white passenger car, possibly a Chrysler New Yorker or similar type car turn left and struck the motorcycle causing the motorcycle to lose control and crash. The white car then failed to remain on scene and left northbound on 12th Street. The vehicle was occupied by 4 subjects. The unidentified motorcyclist suffered serious bodily injury and was transported by ambulance to St. Mary's Hospital.

Case is under investigation and police are asking anyone with information to call the police department 242-6707.
