Warrant Issued for Suspect in June 21st Shooting

(Grand Junction, CO) – Grand Junction Police have obtained a warrant with a \$200,000 bond for Attempted First Degree Murder for Garrett Lee Kulp, age 23, of Grand Junction. Kulp is suspected of discharging a handgun toward another man on Thursday, June 21, 2007.

Shortly before 2:00 a.m. that day, Grand Junction Police Officers responded to 2248 N. 20th Street regarding shots fired. The victim, 22-year-old Julius Wilson, and Kulp had argued and Kulp fired one shot toward Wilson before leaving the scene in a white Pontiac Firebird. The car was later recovered at 488 32 Road in Clifton.

Kulp is still at large and Police are asking for the public's help locating him. Kulp is described as a white male, 5'7", approximately 175 pounds with blond hair and hazel eyes. Anyone with information about Kulp's whereabouts are asked to call the non-emergency dispatch number, 242-6707, or Crime Stoppers at 241-STOP (7867).
