## PRESS RELEASE

### **Grand Junction Man Arrested for Assault, Menacing at Columbine Park**

(Grand Junction, CO) – David Eugene Fulmer II, age 26 of Grand Junction, was arrested last night at Columbine Park, 2830 Orchard Avenue, on one count of First Degree Assault, one count of Second Degree Assault, two counts of Menacing and Reckless Driving.

Officers were dispatched to the park shortly after 8:00 p.m. on July 31<sup>st</sup>, on a report of a fight. When officers arrived, they observed that two adult male victims were bleeding. An investigation revealed that Fulmer allegedly had been driving through the park's parking lot at a high rate of speed, prompting individuals in the park to yell at Fulmer to slow down. Fulmer then stopped, reversed his vehicle, got out and engaged in a confrontation with the individuals. During the fight, Fulmer retrieved a utility knife from his vehicle and cut the two victims.

The victims were treated by Grand Junction Fire medical personnel and then transported by private vehicle to St. Mary's Hospital for further treatment. One victim sustained Serious Bodily Injuries in the altercation. Neither victim's injuries are life-threatening.
