Construction Zone in the GJPD Public Parking Lot!

Public access to public parking lot will be limited to 6th Street only

(Grand Junction, CO) – Motorists are advised that beginning Tuesday, October 9th, access to the Grand Junction Police Department’s Ute Avenue entrance will be permanently closed. All vehicle traffic must enter the police department’s public parking lot from 6th Street.

The Ute Avenue entrance closure was necessary due to the double-wide modular unit that has now become a permanent structure in front of the police building. “Initially we were able to keep the access point due to the fact that the modular was set up as a temporary structure. That has now changed because of traffic safety concerns and structural additions that connect the modular to the main building, including a handicap access ramp and an enclosed walkway structure,” said Services Division Commander Robert Russell.

Construction on the public parking lot will begin Tuesday, October 9th and should be wrapped up by Friday, October 12th.
