Electronic Recycling is the recycling of obsolete electronics. This is when an electronic component is deemed to be at the end of its life and economically worthless. The recycling process occurs when the electronic component is dismantled into its core materials - glass, metal, and plastic. Examples of components often recycled are computer hardware, telecommunication devices, components with complex circuitry and other electronic office equipment such as copy machines and security systems. The concept that a program or event can accept anything with a cord attached to it can cause problems because the possibility of receiving white goods and miscellaneous items such as curling irons can occur.

We ship all electronics to a certified "Universal Waste Handler", who disassembles the equipment to the core material (plastic, glass, metals) which are then packaged by type for sale and recycled back into the industry.
