Public Works Projects For the Week of September 29- October 4, 2008

(This list is arranged in the order by affect on traffic. Those at the top of the list are MOST likely to impact traffic. New projects are in bold.)

26 Road Closure

26 Road is closed to through traffic between G Road and I-70. Access to Bookcliff Gardens Nursery will be from the north on 26 Road. Detours will use both 25 Road and 26 ½ Road, the I-70 Frontage Road, and H and G Roads though the end of September.

G ½ Road

G 1/2 Road is partially open to traffic. Residents from The Estates Subdivision and Blue Heron Meadows Subdivision will be able to use the intersection of G 1/2 Road and Beaver Lodge Road for access. However, G 1/2 Road will remain closed to thru traffic between Beaver Lodge Road and 26 Road.

Colorado Avenue reconstruction

- The 200, 300 and 400 blocks of Colorado Avenue are open to through traffic
- The 500 and 600 blocks are CLOSED to traffic
- The 6th Street and Colorado Avenue intersection is closed until mid-October
- All businesses remain open and pedestrian access will be maintained to all stores
- Use Ute Avenue and Main Street for travel east and west
- Use First and 7th Streets for travel north and south

First Street closure for concrete repair

First Street will be closed from 4 PM Friday, September 26 through Saturday, September 27 for repair of the speed table just south of Bookcliff Avenue. It will reopen on Sunday, September 27. Detours for north and southbound traffic will be on 25 ½ Road or 7th Street.

First Street will also be closed from 4 PM Friday, October 3 through Saturday, October 4 for repair of the speed table at Park Drive. It will reopen on Sunday, October 5. Detours for north and southbound traffic will be on 25 ½ Road or 7th Street.
