PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Pass a criminal background check
- Complete the 35-hour Victim Advocate Training Academy
- Go on a ride-along with an officer
- Complete an interview
- Pass a CVSA screening
- Shadow an experienced Victim Advocate
- Commit to four on-call shifts a month (12 hours each) and one year of service
- Attend a two-hour education/debriefing meeting each month
- Have reliable transportation and current insurance
- Be at least 21 years of age
