GRAND JUNCTION CELEBRATES ARBOR DAY WITH TREE SEEDLING DELIVERY PROGRAM

GRAND JUNCTION, Colo. April 13, 2023 – The City of Grand Junction is celebrating Arbor Day by offering free tree seedlings. Grand Junction residents can request two seedlings that will be delivered to their home address by Forestry Board volunteers and city staff beginning on Wednesday, April 19, 2023. Residents can select the type of tree seedling they would like and make their request [online](#). Supplies are limited and requests are filled on a first-come first-served basis.

“We encourage residents to act quickly as the number of seedlings available are limited and residents look forward to this popular program every year,” said Rob Davis, City Forester and Open Space supervisor. “This unique program creates a memorable tree planting experience for families and serves as a great way to commemorate this year’s Arbor Day.”

“Delivering seedlings to encourage tree planting throughout the community is another way to support and celebrate the city’s urban tree canopy,” continued Davis.

The annual Arbor Day celebration will take place during the [Southwest Arbor Fest](#) starting at 9 a.m. in Lincoln Park on Saturday, April 22, 2023. Seedlings will also be available that day at the entrance to the Lincoln Park pool.
