

# SPLASH PARK AT DOS RIOS RULES

## Thank you for visiting!

For a positive experience for all, please be mindful of the following rules.

See City Park Rules and Regulations for other park rules.

### SPLASH PARK HOURS:

May 1 to September 30 - 1 p.m. to 7 p.m.

### DOS RIOS PARK HOURS:

November 1 to March 1 - 5 a.m. to 8 p.m.

March 2 to October 31 - 5 a.m. to 10 p.m.

- To activate the water features, gently press the green button. Only touch the red button in an emergency.
- Water features will run for 10 minutes; press the green button to re-activate.
- If green button does not activate the water features, it is either not within operating hours or the splash park is temporarily shut down due to contamination, wind, or a plugged drain. It should be re-activated the following day.
- Glass containers, bikes, scooters, and skateboards are prohibited.
- Dogs are prohibited. Dog presence will cause the splash park to shut down.
- No lifeguard is on duty; play at your own risk. Please no running.
- Children must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Children not potty trained must wear a swim diaper. Fecal incidents will cause the splash park to shut down.
- To protect water quality, shampoo, soap, food or other such substances are prohibited.
- On the hour, 1 p.m., 2 p.m., 3 p.m., 4 p.m., 5 p.m., and 6 p.m., sprinklers in the artificial turf area may briefly run to cool off the turf.
- All City parks are smoke free. Tobacco, cannabis, and all vaping devices are prohibited.
- Commercial sales that are pre-authorized allowed by permit only.
