



RIVER PARK at LAS COLONIAS

As you enjoy this facility, please follow these rules:

PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES (PFDs) or Life Jackets are **STRONGLY** recommended.

You are responsible for your safety and the safety of minors you bring to the park. No Lifeguards are present. **Children 12 and under MUST wear a life jacket. Life jackets are FREE to borrow and return at Save-A-Life-Jacket kiosks.**



- Wear a PFD or Life Jacket.
- Look for Yellow & Red caution flags. Yellow indicates a modest hazard, red indicates a high-hazard (no tubes in River Park).
- Stay off the island between the slough and main channel of the river. This is a conservation area.
- Keep dogs leashed, out of the River Park water, and clean up waste. Dogs are allowed off leash in the dog parks.
- Keep to the soft surface paths, especially when using a tube. The area has been re-seeded, walking off trail damages re-vegetation.
- Use boats and paddleboards approved for whitewater, fast currents, and sharp objects.
- Stay away from trees, limbs, and debris around banks. These are drowning hazards.





- Smoking is not allowed, including tobacco, cannabis, and substances delivered through electronic smoking devices (vaping).
- Glass containers are prohibited.
- Swimming in the Butterfly Pond or Las Colonias ponds is not allowed, nor are flotation devices like inner tubes. Stand Up Paddleboards (SUP) and kayaks are encouraged.
- Pool toys are dangerous on the river. Paddleboarders should not wear a leash on the river. Leashes without a breakaway can lead to drowning.
- Golfing is prohibited.
- Stay out of the four side channels. The left turns out of the River Park channel.

STANDARD PARK RULES:

- This park is open from 5:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Preauthorization of commercial sales is required.
