

RiverFront at Las Colonias Frequently Asked Questions

Where can I rent river equipment?

River equipment is available for rent from GJ SUP at Las Colonias. They can provide you with kayaks, paddle boards, and tubes to enjoy the River Park. GJ SUP is located on the east end of Las Colonias Park, in between in the Butterfly Pond and the boat ramp. Please visit their [website](#) for rental pricing.

Is the facility free to use?

Yes! Las Colonias Park is free for the public to enjoy.

Can I fish at Las Colonias?

Las Colonias Park is a multi-recreational area. Fishing is allowed on the Colorado River which can be accessed through the park. If fishing, please do not block the boat ramp exit/entrance and please be aware of other users in the area.

Are dogs allowed?

Dogs are not allowed in the River Park or ponds. If you are enjoying other amenities such as the soft or hard surface trails or open space, dogs need to be kept on a leash. There will be dog parks available at Las Colonias soon!

Where does the River Park begin and end?

The River Park begins near the boat ramp and ends near the Las Colonias Amphitheater. Please use caution when entering and exiting the River Park, as there are side channels leading to the main Colorado River channel. Is there beach space available for a daily rental fee?

There is no beach space available for rent. Beach and wading areas are on a first come first serve basis. The shelters at Las Colonias will be available for rent soon!

Where can I swim at Las Colonias?

Swimming is only allowed in the River Park. Swimming is not allowed in the Butterfly or Las Colonias Ponds, only kayaks and paddle boards are allowed on the ponds.

Where should I set-up my lounge chairs for the day?

There are beach and wading areas along the River Park for you to enjoy. Please follow the signage posted around the park locating where lounge chairs should **not** be set-up. Las Colonias Park is a new amenity with development happening all

around. Some areas are being treated to help with grass growth. Please be mindful of where you set-up your seating.

What time does Las Colonias close and open?

The park is open from 5:00 AM – 10:00 PM daily.
