

Waterwise Lawn Program Checklist

Eligibility for the program

- Property must be in the City of Grand Junction Water service area.
- For residential properties, a minimum of 300 to 2,000 square feet of grass is required.
- For non-residential properties, 300 to 5,000 square feet of grass is required. (Areas more than 5,000 square feet, contact the Water Conservation Specialist)
- Living high-water grass must be present, and the application must be approved before removing any grass.

How to apply for the program

- Meet with the Water Conservation Specialist for consultation to review the desired plan and schedule an irrigation audit.
- Complete [application](#).
 - The Water Conservation Specialist will review it in the order received.

Reimbursement Criteria

- Approval must be obtained from the Water Conservation Specialist before starting the project. Call 811 before digging!
- Completion must occur within the stated time frame (not exceeding 6 months).
- All costs must be documented, and receipts should be kept.
- After completing the project, notify the Water Conservation Specialist for an inspection.

Important notes

- All local rules and regulations must be followed.
- After finishing the landscape, the city will monitor water usage to see if it decreases.
- For assistance with watering the new landscape, contact the Water Conservation Specialist or Colorado State University Extension office.



- Evaluation of tree health and retention is essential. Ensure that trees are adequately watered during this process. Contact either the Water Conservation Specialist or the City Forester for a thorough assessment.

For businesses and HOAs

- Participation in the program is possible with specific guidelines, including approval from Community Development. There may be associated fees. Contact Community Development at 970-244-1430.
