**Monday through Friday 7 a.m. - 4 p.m.**

**Saturday from 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.**

The drop off may close due to high winds.  
The drop off is free and open to the public. There is no payout for materials.

## Recycling Procedure

**Read signs carefully**

**Monitor children closely**

**Keep pets in vehicle**

Pull as far forward as possible

Park only in right lane

Left lane for through traffic only

## Prohibited Materials

NO plastic bags

NO E-waste/electronics

NO appliances or scrap metal

NO batteries or light bulbs

NO hazardous waste

NO sharps/needles/medical waste

NO hygiene products or diapers

**Dumping of trash or unacceptable material is prohibited.**

## Resource Stewardship

**All products listed in this guide are sent to market, never landfilled.** Materials that meet guidelines and arrive at the recycling center will be recycled. All recycled materials have a strong, domestic market and are sent to U.S. mills.

## Identifying Plastics

Recyclable plastics have a number printed on the bottom of the container or on the label.

**ONLY #1, #2, & #5  
bottles, jars, jugs, & tubs  
are accepted.**

# DROP OFF RECYCLING GUIDELINES

## ALUMINUM, STEEL, & PLASTIC




### Acceptable

ONLY #1, #2, & #5 plastic bottles, jars, jugs, & tubs, aluminum & tin cans/lids, #1 cups (clear), #1 blister/clamshell (clear)



### Prohibited

NO plastic #3, #4, #6, #7, plastic bags/wrappers/film, aluminum foil/tin, styrofoam, straws, motor oil containers



## CLEAR GLASS



### Acceptable

ONLY bottles & jars  
Remove lids & corks



### Prohibited

NO dishes, ceramics, pyrex, drinking glass, vases, lightbulbs, clay, pane glass



## CHIPBOARD



### Acceptable

Cereal/cracker boxes, soda/beer cases, posterboard, paper towel tubes



### Prohibited

NO paper cups, wax-coated milk/juice cartons or containers, corrugated cardboard



## CORRUGATED CARDBOARD



### Acceptable

ONLY clean cardboard  
Break down & flatten



### Prohibited

NO packing material, styrofoam, corner braces, greasy pizza boxes, molded pulp packaging, paper towel tubes, paper



## COLORED GLASS



### Acceptable

ONLY bottles & jars  
Remove lids & corks



### Prohibited

NO dishes, ceramics, pyrex, drinking glass, vases, lightbulbs, clay, pane glass



## PAPER



### Acceptable

Newspaper, mail, office paper, magazines, paper egg cartons, paperback books, phonebooks, calendars, molded pulp packaging



### Prohibited

NO plastic bags, paper cups, paper towels, toilet paper, cardboard, chipboard, photographs, paper clips, hardback books
