What are the contents of my Official Mail Ballot Packet?

- Official Ballot
- Secrecy Sleeve with Voter Instructions
- Official Return Envelope

How do I vote my ballot?

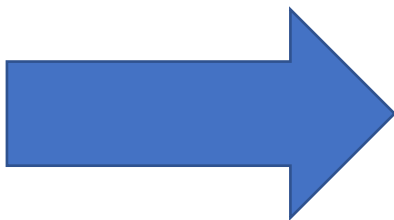
Follow all the voting instructions shown on your ballot. After you have marked all your voting choices and finished voting:

1. Refold your ballot along the original fold lines.
2. Place your voted ballot in this Secrecy Sleeve.
3. Place the Secrecy Sleeve (with voted ballot) into the Official Return Envelope.
4. Print your name on the designated line in the "Self-Affirmation" located on the back of the Official Return Envelope.
5. Sign and date the "Self-Affirmation." See example below.

Only one voter's ballot is permitted in your Official Return Envelope.

If more than one ballot is placed in your Official Return Envelope, none of the ballots will be counted.

By law, your signature is required on the Self-Affirmation (located on the back of the Official Return Envelope). If you do not sign the self-affirmation, your ballot will not be counted.

Return your ballot

You may return your voted ballot by mail or you may hand deliver your ballot to a Designated Ballot Drop Box location. See following for a list of these locations.

Ballots must be RECEIVED at the Mesa County Elections office or a Designated Ballot Drop Box location **by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day** in order for your vote to be counted. Ballots received after 7:00 p.m. on April 6, 2021 will not be counted.

Postmarks do not count as a received date. You must apply appropriate postage if returning ballot by mail.

Where can I drop off my ballot?

There are five designated ballot drop box locations. All will be available beginning March 15, 2021 through Election Day, April 6, 2021. The locations are:
