Right of Way Tree Protection Permit

A Right-of-Way Tree Protection Permit is required for all work that will impact the health and well-being of trees on City property and Right-of Ways (ROW). This permit is \$25 and is <u>not</u> an annual fee, but required for each project. Contractors and employees of the City are required strict adherence to Chapter 8.32 of the Municipal Code and the Forestry Standards and Specifications. Failure to comply will result in fines or penalty.
