

## Grand Junction Sales and Use Tax FYI

### Sales by School Associations

The City of Grand Junction exempts from sales tax sales made by schools, school activity booster organizations, and student classes or organizations if all proceeds of the sale are for the benefit of a school or school-approved student organization. Sec 3.12.070 (qq)

School for the purposes of Sec. 3.12.070 includes both public and nonpublic schools for students in kindergarten through twelfth grade or any portion thereof. Preschools, trade schools, and post-secondary schools are not eligible for this exemption.
