

Grand Junction Sales and Use Tax FYI

Agricultural Compounds

The City of Grand Junction's Sales and Use Tax Ordinances specifically exempt the following:

- Sale of feed for livestock, poultry or horses. Sec. 3.12.070 (s)
- Sale of seed and orchard trees. Sec. 3.12.070 (t)
- Neat cattle, sheep, lambs, fish for stock purposes, swine and goats; mares and stallions for breeding purposes. Sec. 3.12.070 (r)
- Farm implements, and parts and accessories for farm implements. Sec. 3.12.070 (ii)
- Drugs dispensed in accordance with a prescription. Sec. 3.12.070 (i)

Prescription drugs for animals means a drug which, prior to being dispensed or delivered, is required by the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, 21 U.S.C. Section 301 et seq., as amended, to state at a minimum the symbol "Rx Only," and is dispensed in accordance with any order in writing, dated and signed by a licensed veterinarian specifying the animal for which the medicine or drug is offered and directions, if any, to be placed on the label.
