TAX RATE INCREASE NOTIFICATION AND ONLINE FILING REQUIREMENT

On April 4, 2023, the voters of Grand Junction authorized a 0.14% increase in the sales and use tax rate (tax rate) for the City of Grand Junction, effective July 1, 2023. This tax increase will generate revenue to finance the costs of debt service, construction, equipping, and furnishing, and, if available, operating and maintaining an indoor community recreation center (CRC) at Matchett Park. The voter-authorized tax increase is in effect until December 31, 2054, which is the expected term of the debt required to construct the facility.

The 0.14% tax rate increase will be collected on all sales and use taxable transactions in the same manner as the current 3.25% tax rate in accordance with the Grand Junction Municipal Code 3.12.030 et seq. The new 3.39% tax rate becomes effective for transactions occurring on or after July 1, 2023. This means the new tax rate will first be reported on the tax returns due on August 20, 2023, or later.

Earlier this year the City converted to a new tax administration system and we are now requiring all sales and use tax returns, starting with the July 2023 or the second quarter 2023 return, to be submitted through our online portal:
